Frederic Bouillaud

University of Paris Descartes



Dr. Frédéric Bouillaud is studying the mitochondrial metabolism of the gasotransmitter H₂S. He obtained his research degree in Membrane biophysics in 1982 and in his ScD in Endocrinology in 1983. At present he is head of the team «Mitochondria Bioenergetics, Metabolism and Signaling» at the Institut Cochin, Université René Descartes, Paris.
